U.S. Department of the Treasury, Bureau of the Public Debt

The U.S. Department of the Treasury will end over-the-counter sales of paper savings bonds on December 31, 2011, including sales through financial institutions and applications mailed directly to the Federal Reserve Bank by customers. This move is expected to save taxpayers an estimated \$70 million over the next five years.

Although paper bonds are being discontinued, electronic Series EE and Series I Savings Bonds will remain available for purchase via TreasuryDirect. This secure, web-based system, operated by the Bureau of the Public Debt, has been used by investors since 2002 to purchase savings bonds online.

Customers will no longer be able to buy paper savings bonds through a financial institution or mail order. They can purchase, manage and redeem electronic savings bonds online through www.treasurydirect.gov. Electronic savings bonds are secure and convenient to manage through TreasuryDirect, and investors no longer have to worry about misplacing, losing or storing savings bonds. In addition, with a TreasuryDirect account, customers can purchase electronic savings bonds as gifts and also convert paper savings bonds to electronic.

Customers have until the close of December 31, 2011 to submit their final purchase applications for paper savings bonds. Final applications mailed directly to the Federal Reserve by customers must be received by December 31, 2011.

There are currently more than 670 million paper bonds worth \$181 billion in the hands of the public. Banks will continue redeeming those paper bonds on behalf of their customers. Paper bonds which have not yet matured but are lost, stolen or destroyed can be reissued in paper or electronic form.

Opening a TreasuryDirect account is free, and, once it's established, investors can:

- Buy, manage, and redeem Series EE and I electronic through the SmartExchange feature.
- Convert Series EE and I paper savings bonds as a gift.
- Enroll in a payroll savings plan for purchasing electronic bonds.
- Invest in other Treasury securities such as bills, notes, bonds, and TIPS (Treasury Inflation-Protected Securities.)

Series I paper savings bonds remain available for purchase using part of all of one's tax refund. For more information about the elimination of paper savings bonds and how to enroll in TreasuryDirect, visit www.treasurydirect.gov.
